



## Jura Learning Objectives

Understand how key historical, political, geographical, geological, topographical, and climatic factors have influenced the viti/vini practices of Jura and its wine styles

### By the end of this lesson, the student will be able to...

Locate Jura on a map of France

Identify the storied history of Savagnin and identify its link to other French grapes

Recall how wine production in the Jura changed over the last 150 years

Know the difference between wines made “*sous voile*” and wines made “*ouillé*”

Name important historical figures from the region and detail their contributions to wine

Describe Jura’s climate and the topographical features that impact it

Define “graben”; name the two uplifts of the Saône Graben

Identify the predominant soil types of the Jura region

Accurately describe the nature of a blind valley

Know the five principal grapes and their preferred soil types

Identify the most common training system in the Jura and explain why it is preferred

Know the role of ullage in Jura winemaking

Explain the winemaking processes involved in Vin Jaune, Vin de Paille, and Macvin production

Recognize the difference between oxidative and reductive winemaking (Fundamentals Unit)

Know the AOCs of Jura, the wine styles they produce, and the major grapes within each
